**MEDIA RELEASE**

As part of the ongoing reform of the civil justice delivery process at the High Court, aimed at greater access to justice to a greater majority of people at reasonable cost and with minimum delay, the High Court of the Republic of Namibia will be hosting a workshop on *Judicial Case-Flow Management and the Rules of Court* from 31 July – 2 August 2013 in Windhoek. The workshop will be attended by judges, legal practitioners and candidate legal practitioners. The twin objectives of the workshop are:

1. To undertake a frank assessment of Namibia's experience with case management since its introduction in May 2011, and to learn from the experiences of other jurisdictions; and
2. To introduce the profession to the proposed new rules and how they will impact on the practice of law in the High Court.

The workshop will be conducted in two parts: one part focussing on the judges of the High Court and the other part on the practising profession. A senior judge and a senior practitioner from two common law jurisdictions have been invited to serve as faculty, together with local judges and practitioners.

The workshop is funded by the Ministry of Justice. The High Court also acknowledges the American Embassy's sponsorship of the Honourable Mr Justice David Campbell of the Arizona Federal District Court as faculty at the workshop. The Workshop will be officially opened by the Honourable Chief Justice, Justice Peter Shivute, on 31 July 2013 at 16H00 at the Supreme Court of Namibia. The media is invited to cover the event.
